Discover our roots.



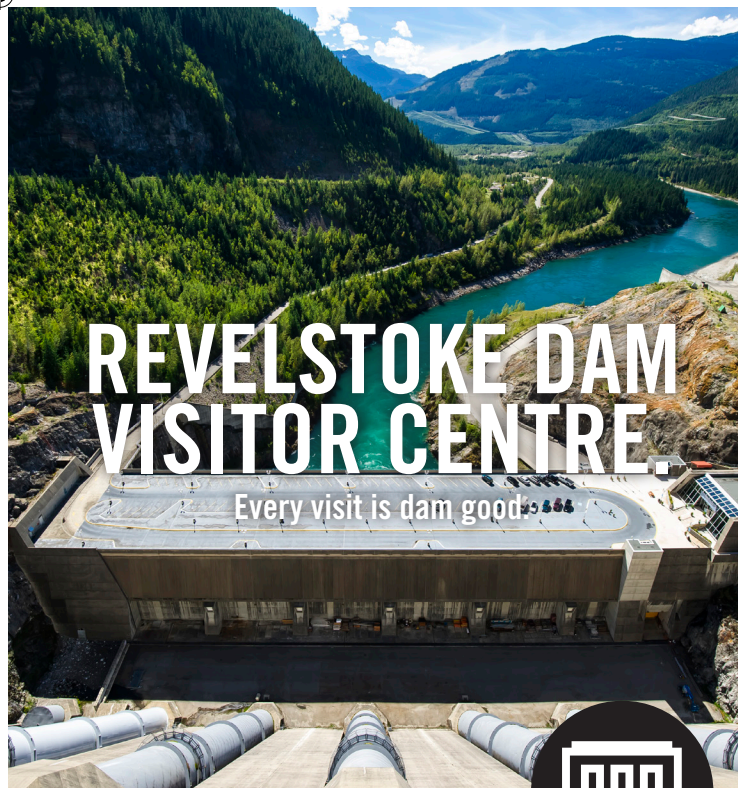
- **LEARN** the history of how hard the good old days were for the pioneers of forestry in BC.

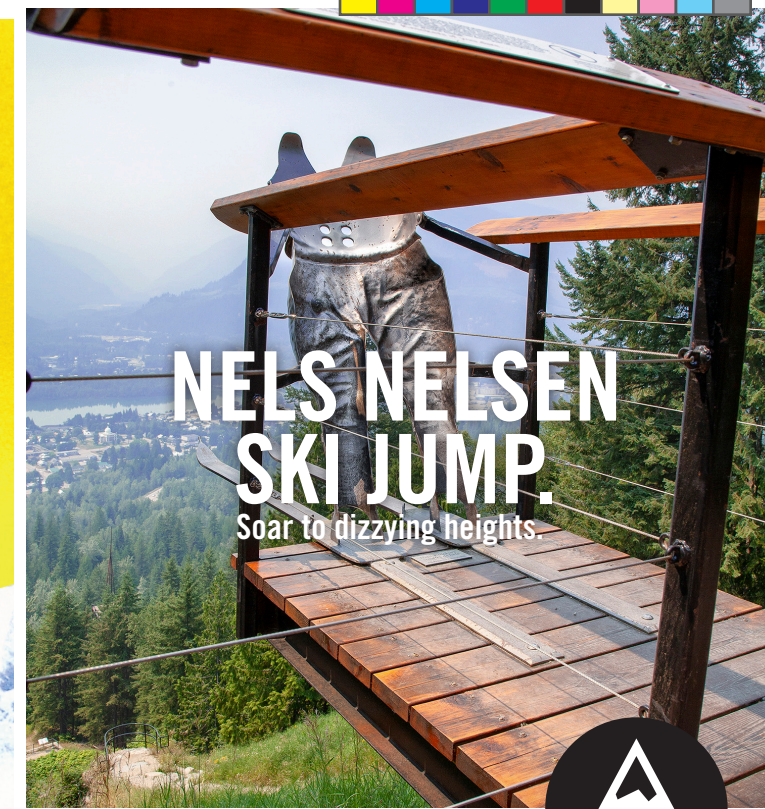
