#### HALCYON HOT SPRINGS

There are two hot pools, a cold plunge, and a seasonal mineral pool.

#### HALFWAY HOT SPRINGS

The Halfway River Hot Springs are the most rugged of the nearby hot springs, accessed by a logging road and a steep trail.

#### **CRAZY CREEK RESORT**

Outdoor Hot Pools immersed in nature! 3 pools ranging from 40°C to the 12°C cold dip, plus a seasonal pool open May-October. Hot pools are open 365 Days a Year.

Wheel chair accessible and RV, campsites, and lodging available.



#### **CANYON HOT SPRINGS**

The mineral waters of Albert Canyon were allegedly discovered by CPR workmen at the turn of the century.

They built a timber enclosure at the site of the springs as this was used as a pool until the townsite was abandoned when the Canadian Pacific Railway removed the maintenance post.

Today, water from the spring is piped almost 2 miles down the valley side to feed the 15,000 gallon hot pool and our 60,000 gallon swimming pool. The Hot Mineral Soaking Pool temperature is 104°F (40°C) and the swimming pool is 86°F (32°C).

Full campground, cabin, and RV facilities available.
